

Instructions - Canvas

- Use green ink to distress the edges of the stretched canvas.
- Sweet Pea Cardstock – Use the border/corner punch (Poinsettia Flourish) to make detail around the page.
 - ✓ Use green ink to distress the edges of the punched cardstock
 - ✓ “Scrunch” the edges of the paper to give it dimension and a more vintage look.
 - ✓ Adhere the paper to the canvas with a liquid adhesive (i.e., Modge Podge). Do not apply adhesive to the edges...allow them to curl up from your scrunching.
 - ✓ Be sure to let adhesive dry before continuing – it will take slightly longer than usual for canvas to dry.
- Constance Cardstock – Cut a piece 12” x 1-1/2”. Use the border punch (Love) to trim the strip on both sides to create a “ribbon” strip.
- Aunt Cardstock – Use a deckle edge cutter/scissors to trim a piece 12” x 1/4” (deckle both sides).
 - ✓ Adhere the green deckled-edged strip on top of the cream dotted border-punched strip.
 - ✓ Using either the border punch or the deckle scissors, trim the edges slightly to fit across the purple background.
 - ✓ Adhere the two strips toward the bottom edge of the canvas.
- Mat Photo(s)
 - ✓ The sample uses a 5” x 7” photo. Use Sweet Pea cardstock to mat the photo – (5-1/4” x 7-1/4”).
 - ✓ Cut a piece of Bewitched cardstock (7-1/4” X 1-1/2”). Deckle cut one edge. Use green ink to distress edges. Adhere behind one side of matted photo.
 - ✓ Cut Constance cardstock (7” x 8-1/2”). Use green ink to distress edges. Adhere matted photo to lower left edge of cardstock.
 - ✓ Adhere completed matted photo to canvas where desired.
- Leaves/Flourish
 - ✓ Use Winter Joy cardstock to create leaves/flourish. Cut two pieces using the Bella Rose Die.
 - It takes practice to remove the paper from the die without tearing...but no problem, as each small piece can be used. The full cut is never actually used.
 - Add dimension by distressing the pieces with green ink – lightly on the flourish; heavier on the leaves.
 - Carefully “pinch” the tips of the leaves to give dimension.
 - Adhere leaves/flourish as desired around the photo(s)/page.



- Flowers
 - ✓ Use Creative Imaginations (cream – striped side) cardstock to make flowers.
 - ✓ Flowers are stamped with pigment ink using the Malabar Clematis stamp set. (23 flowers of various sizes were used.)
 - ✓ Emboss flowers with Distress Embossing powder.
 - ✓ Cut flowers by hand or using the Heartfelt Creations accompanying die set – Cross and Lilies Die
 - ✓ Fold each flower petal in half to give dimension to flowers.
 - ✓ Have fun arranging (and rearranging) flowers on canvas. Adhere when happy with the look!
- Finishing Embellishments
 - ✓ Butterflies
 - Use the Large Monarch punch to punch three butterflies out of with Winter Joy cardstock.
 - Fold butterflies in half to give dimension.
 - Adhere to canvas where desired, using adhesive just along bottom of body – fold wings up for dimension.
 - ✓ Pearl Rope
 - Cut three 6” pieces of pearl rope.
 - Fold each strip in half and adhere behind flowers as desired.
 - ✓ Liquid Pearls
 - Use Liquid Pearls to add three “pearls” to the bodies of each butterfly.
 - ✓ Lace/Ribbon Trim
 - Finish the sides of your canvas by covering with coordinating lace or ribbon.

Instructions - Globeframes

- Left Globe
 - ✓ Use bottom layer to trace paper – Winter Joy cardstock used,
 - ✓ Use top layer to trace paper – Sweet Pea cardstock used.
 - ✓ Middle layer of Globeframe is not used...you may do so if you wish.
 - ✓ Adhere cut cardstock to top of layers.
 - ✓ Use green ink to distress edges (both inside and outside).
 - ✓ Adhere the clear globe to bottom layer of frame.
 - ✓ Center photo in clear globe – trim if needed. Adhere photo with a THIN layer of adhesive on clear globe edges.
 - ✓ Adhere to Globeframe bottom.
 - ✓ Using pop-dots, adhere top layer to Globeframe.
 - ✓ Embellish with leaves/flourish and flowers to embellish frame front.
 - Two leaves/flourish and twelve flowers were used in sample for all three frames.
 - Distress as indicated in canvas instructions.
 - Adhere leaves/flourish and flowers where desired.
 - ✓ Embellish with butterflies.
 - One butterfly from the 3-in-1 Classic Butterfly punch was used.
 - ✓ Embellish with Liquid Pearls as desired.



- Right Globe
 - ✓ Use bottom layer to trace paper – Winter Joy cardstock used,
 - ✓ Use middle layer to trace paper – Constance cardstock used.
 - ✓ Top layer of Globeframe is not used...you may do so if you wish.
 - ✓ Adhere cut cardstock to top of layers.
 - ✓ Use green ink to distress edges (both inside and outside).
 - ✓ Adhere the clear globe to bottom layer of frame.
 - ✓ Center photo in clear globe – trim if needed. Adhere photo with a THIN layer of adhesive on clear globe edges.
 - ✓ Adhere to Globeframe bottom.
 - ✓ Using pop-dots, adhere middle layer to Globeframe.
 - ✓ Embellish with leaves/flourish and flowers to embellish frame front.
 - Two leaves/flourish and twelve flowers were used in sample for all three frames.
 - Distress as indicated in canvas instructions.
 - Adhere leaves/flourish and flowers where desired.
 - ✓ Embellish with Liquid Pearls as desired.



- Middle Globe
 - ✓ Use bottom layer to trace paper – Creative Imaginations striped cardstock used,
 - ✓ Top layer of Globeframe is not used...you may do so if you wish.
 - ✓ Adhere cut cardstock to top of layer.
 - ✓ Use green ink to distress edges (both inside and outside).
 - ✓ Adhere the clear globe to bottom layer of frame.
 - ✓ Center photo/sentiment in clear globe – trim if needed. Adhere photo with a THIN layer of adhesive on clear globe edges.
 - In the sample, the wedding date/location was printed with green ink on Creative Imaginations dotted cardstock.
 - The sentiment was embellished with three butterflies from the 3-in-1 Classic Butterfly punch. The butterflies were embossed using a Swiss Dots embossing folder. Liquid Pearls were used on the butterfly bodies.
 - ✓ Adhere to Globeframe bottom.
 - ✓ Embellish with leaves/flourish and flowers to embellish frame front.
 - Two leaves/flourish and twelve flowers were used in sample for all three frames.
 - Distress as indicated in canvas instructions.
 - Adhere leaves/flourish and flowers where desired.
 - ✓ Embellish with 6" of pearl rope.
 - ✓ Embellish with Liquid Pearls as desired.
