

# Zentangled Airship

## Instruction Sheet

### Instructions

The Steampunk Airship kit comes with direction for a see-through airship as shown on the front of the kit package. This specific project is only one-sided, however, as I chose to include a Zentangled background.

- Background
  - ✓ Cut white cardstock to fit airship frame.
  - ✓ Using chipboard frame as a guide, draw several hot-air balloons in various sizes and shapes. Zentangle balloons as desired.

- Gears

- ✓ Gears and pipe are covered with Textured Black Enamel and Vintage Rose Gold Enamel.
- ✓ For best results, complete each gear separately. Cover all parts of airship except gear with Post-it-Notes. Use pigment ink or embossing powder adhesive to cover gear. Cover with enamel powder. Heat set with heat gun.
- ✓ I added a dot of gold Stickles in the center of black gears and black enamel in the center of gold gears. Arrange gears and pipe as desired. I also used gold Stickles on balloon baskets.
- ✓ Bottom layer of engine is covered with Butterscotch Enamel Powder. Top layer of engine is covered with Vintage Rose Gold Enamel. Pop-dot gold engine layer on top of butterscotch engine layer.



- Tail

- ✓ Cover each side of tails with white cardstock and trim to size.
- ✓ Cover half of each tail with Post-it-Notes. Cover the other half of each tail with Textured Black Enamel Powder.
- ✓ Zentangle white sides of tail pieces.



- Nose and Boat

- ✓ Cover nose of airship with Textured Black Enamel.
- ✓ Cover bottom of boat with Vintage Rose Gold Enamel.
- ✓ Cover top of boat with Textured Black Enamel.
- ✓ Adhere top of boat to bottom of boat.



- Front Frame

- ✓ Trim a piece of red cardstock to fit front frame.
- ✓ Zentangle trimmed red cardstock as desired.
- ✓ Glue to front frame chipboard. (I cut off the two thin tails on the front and back frames – this is optional.)

- Assemble Airship

- ✓ Glue the white Zentangled background to the middle layer of the airship (layer with gears and engine).
- ✓ I glued an extra piece of oval chipboard behind the white. However, this is optional if you do not have such a piece available.
- ✓ The kit provides three oval “frames” for a two-sided project. Since this project is single sided, there is one oval frame left over. Glue that frame to the back of the airship to secure white cardstock background in place and give project a more finished look.
- ✓ Glue bubble frame inside front Zentangled oval frame. Adhere this to front of airship with pop dots.
- ✓ Assemble tails as shown in kit directions.
